1	Workshops on health with girls and women	Banaras, Uttar Pradesh	April 2018 – March 2019	Workshops included topics such as reproductive system, menstruation as well as problems and myths concerning the same and menstrual hygiene; contraceptives methods like condoms (male and female both) oral pills, emergency contraceptive pills and IUDs, infertility, etc. Separate workshops (six with girls and women each) were conducted during this period.
2	Workshops on health with girls and women	Ranchi, Jharkhand	April 2018- March 2019	Five workshops were conducted with girls and women on topics including nutrition and menstrual health, reproduction, contraception, prolapse, etc. as well as health schemes on maternal health, adolescent health, etc.
3	Workshops for adolescents in Delhi	Delhi- North East District	April 2018 - December 2018	Sama organized several discussions on issues ranging from menstrual health, nutrition, sexual health, HIV, etc. Film screenings were organized for adolescent boys and girls who attended along with their parents and ASHA workers; issues such as taboos around menstruation, sexual abuse/harassment, gender inequality, etc. were discussed.
4	Capacity Building Workshop with groups on 'Odisha Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) on Health System's Response to GBV'	Bhubaneswar, Odisha	19-20 March 2018	Sama along with Jan Swasthya Abhiyan-Odisha organized a one and half day state level workshop in Bhubaneswar with organizations from Odisha - representatives from community-based organizations, networks, women's groups, JSA members and individuals working on issues of gender, women empowerment, rural development etc. participated

5	Study on Infertility, childlessness, and healthcare-seeking in resource-poor settings in India	New Delhi	April 2018 – March 2019	In-depth interviews were conducted with those women who agreed to share their experiences, as well as with some of their mothers-in-law. The team also spoke to providers like ASHA workers and Ayurvedic practitioners regarding their opinions and perceptions around the issue of infertility.
6	Panel discussion on 'How to Approach Rape Survivors' at Lady Hardinge Medical College, Delhi	Lady Hardinge Medical College, Delhi	May 2018	A Sama representative presented on the medico-legal protocol by the MoHFW and discussed issues and gaps that are common in hospitals, especially Delhi hospitals based on Sama's work and experience. The panel was attended by students and faculty of the hospital, especially undergraduate medical students.
7	Three Day Course on 'Ethical and Legal Issues in 'New Frontiers' In Bio- Medical Research'.	Hyderabad, Telangana	13-15 July 2018	Sama conducted its 5th Institute on ethical conduct in biomedical research, post-trial access to medicines, regulation and Law. A three-day course titled "Ethical and Legal issues in 'New Frontiers' in Bio-medical Research".
8	Research Project- "Assessing the Status of Health System Delivery and Factors Determining Access to Quality Healthcare for Tribal Communities" by Sama in collaboration with the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC)	Select areas of Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh and Odisha	April 2018- June 2018	Analysis of the data from the study was carried out and the report "From the Margins to the Centre" based on the study along with detailed recommendations to various government departments was sent to the NHRC. A presentation based on the findings was also made to the Chairperson and members of the NHRC.
